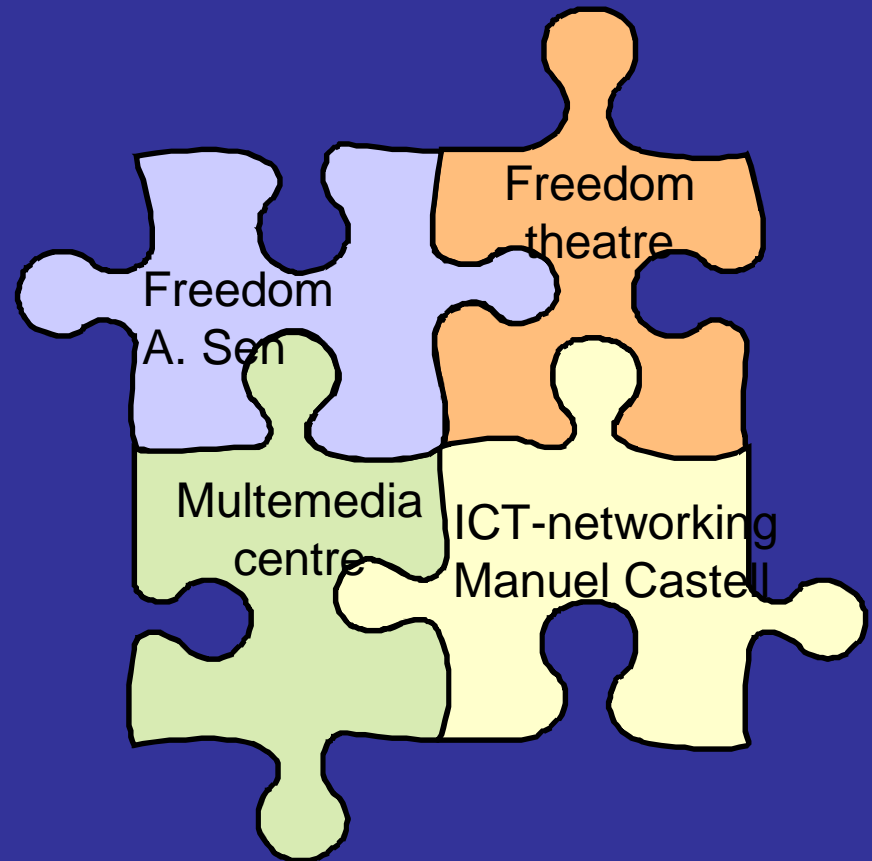

- Total n of ICT participants: 328 (48% girls)
 - Age range: 9-17
 - Education level (Primary to Secondary)
- Total n of theatre participants:
 - 274 (Training) (48% girls)
 - Age range: 8-20
 - Education level (Primary to Secondary)
 - 14.310 (audience)

TFT-ICT work outcome, so far

- Established a website by and for youth (www.voices.ps)
- Online publication of the Refuge book
- Publication of the first edition of the “Voices” magazine
- Creation of six short films
- Two photo exhibitions
- Increased political and social awareness
- Increased computer literacy in Jenin Refugee Camp
- Jenin case study (manuscript)
